

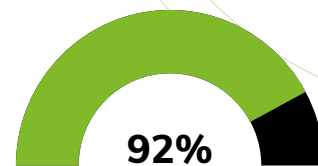
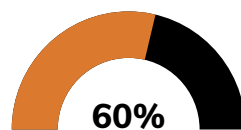
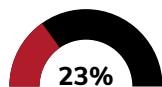
# Making a positive impact on inclusive learning around the globe

## Fix Your Content Day

Accessibility and inclusion is a journey, not a destination, and at Anthology we treasure our commitment to helping institutions along this path. To that end, we're bringing back **Fix Your Content Day (FYCD)**, a 24-hour global competition which challenges participants to create accessible and more inclusive digital learning content through Anthology Ally for **Global Accessibility Awareness Day (GAAD)** on May 18th.

Our goal for the day is simple: make a positive impact on inclusive learning around the globe. By enrolling in the competition, colleges and universities are challenged to make as many "fixes" as possible to course files and improve their accessibility by using **Anthology Ally**. In the lead-up to the challenge, institutions are welcome to motivate the campus for the competition, plan strategies, and prepare ahead of time for the day. Remember, the fixes need to happen through the Anthology Ally User Interface to be counted in the contest.

Are you up for the challenge?



When the clock strikes May 18th in the first time zone on Earth (Kiribati), the global leaderboard is launched, and the competition begins. Leveraging usage data from Anthology Ally, the leaderboard ranks each participating institution by their total number of files improved out of their total number of students, and also tallies the total number of files improved across all Ally users over the 24 hours.
