Assessment & Accreditation: Share your research papers that examine assessment frameworks, accreditation processes, and strategies to ensure quality education, improve student learning outcomes, and support institutional effectiveness.

Course Design and Development: Share your research, innovative methodologies, and evidence-based practices that focus on designing and developing inclusive, learner-centered courses to foster meaningful learning experiences and enhance student engagement and success.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion: We welcome contributions that explore the impact of diverse and inclusive educational practices, policies, and interventions on student success, equity, and fostering an inclusive learning environment.

Faculty Professional Development: Share your research papers that focus on effective professional development strategies, programs, and initiatives aimed at enhancing faculty teaching practices, promoting innovation, and ultimately improving student engagement and success.

Student Engagement and Success: Share your insights, strategies, and empirical findings that explore the role of various factors, such as instructional approaches, technology integration, and student support services, in fostering student engagement and promoting academic success.

Teaching Best Practices: We seek scholarly contributions that highlight effective teaching strategies, pedagogical innovations, and evidence-based approaches that promote student learning, engagement, and achievement.

Using Data in Education: We seek contributions that investigate the effective utilization of data-driven approaches, analytics, and technologies in education to inform decision-making, enhance instructional practices, and improve student outcomes.

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Submission Guidelines and Tips

- We suggest using a laptop or desktop computer rather than a mobile device to ensure a successful submission.
- Sessions will be 30 minutes in length and can be given by one or more speakers/institutions on a topic of interest or case study with time for questions and answers.
- All presentations must be 16:9 format.
- Multiple submission entries may be made for different presentations.
- All prospective presenters must register their details in order to be considered.
- You can create, save a draft, and edit your submission up until the submission deadline on 7 September 2023.
- The program team will communicate with the individual who submitted the proposal. It is the submitter/presenter's responsibility to communicate and coordinate all other aspects of the presentation with any co-presenters.

Submission Checklist

Presenter Information: You will be asked to provide contact information, a headshot, and a bio (maximum 600 characters) for each presenter.

Session Title: Use the title of your session to capture attendee attention, show your perspective, and emphasize the value of your session. Generic titles won't properly communicate your subject matter! (Maximum 100 characters)

Session Description: This summary will be included in the agenda to give attendees more information on the content of your session. This should be a clear, concise description of why an attendee should attend your session and what they will walk away with. (Maximum 600 characters)

Topic: Select the program topic that best aligns with your presentation.

Learning Outcomes: Please share what attendees will gain from attending your presentation.

Additional Submission Details: This is where you will share additional details about your session with the review committee. Show your creativity, highlight high-level participant takeaways/learning objectives, identify session objectives, and describe any plans for audience engagement and session flow. Check out the evaluation rubric for more information on what we're looking for. (Maximum 3,000 characters)

FAQs

What is the deadline for submission? The deadline to <u>submit a proposal</u> for Anthology Together is 7 September 2023.

How do I submit a proposal?

All proposals must be submitted online in our <u>submission portal</u>. You can start at any time and save your proposal to complete later. We suggest using a laptop or desktop computer rather than a mobile device to ensure a successful submission.

Can I submit more than one proposal?

You may submit more than one proposal; however, keep in mind we typically only accept one proposal per person.

How can I view the status of my submission? You may log in to the CFP portal at any time to check the status of your submission.

What if there are multiple presenters in my session? One person should take the lead in submitting the session. They will be the main point of contact for information regarding the session.
