Because of this, institutions are increasingly designing their e-learning courses with inclusivity in mind. Building a Solid Foundation for Accessible eLearning

Institutional Readiness is a discovery service designed to analyse and report on an insitution's readiness for an institutional-wide deployment of accessible course and learning designs. The assessment encompasses strategic, technical and cultural readiness, including policy, processes, systems and people. In a two-day onsite engagement, Blackboard consultants review the institution's:

- Accessibility requirements
- Existing policies and process
- Internal capacity and capabilities to make effective use of Blackboard Ally to create accessible course designs

Outcome: a report and recommendations for improving institutional readiness for the deployment at scale of accessible course and learning designs, as well as recommendations for a high-level improvement workflow for creating accessible e-learning courses and materials.

Result: an institution is equipped to move from pockets of good practice to large scale adoption.

TRAINING: Creating Awareness ad Understanding of Accessibility and Accessible Content
